

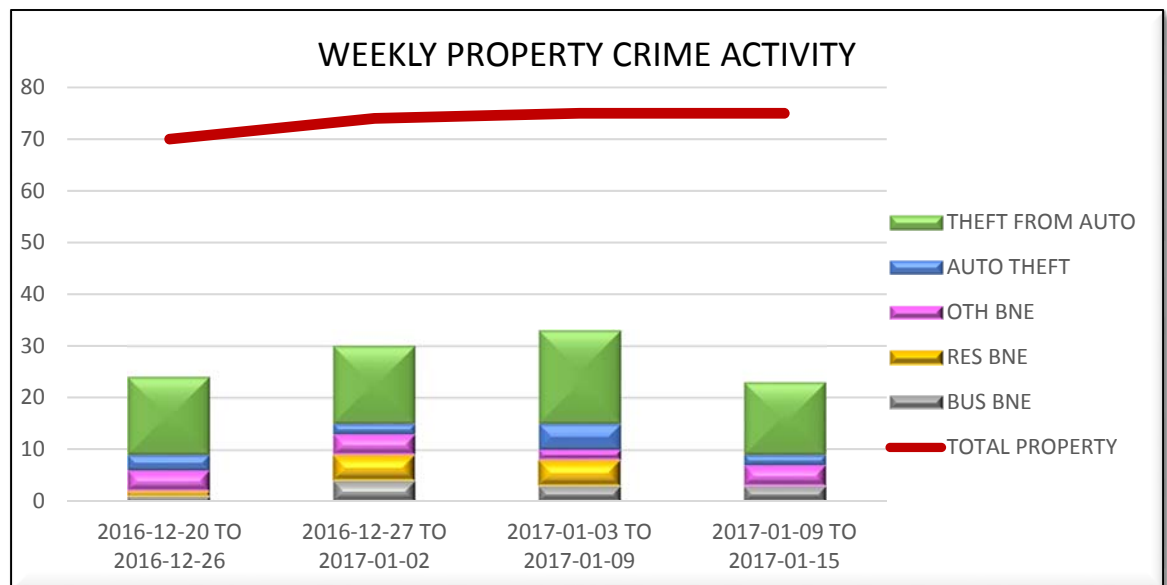
OFFENCE ACTIVITY WEEK IN REVIEW - 2017-01-09 TO 2017-01-15

D1: Tsawwassen D2: Ladner/Tilbury D3: North Delta/Annacis D4: Scottsdale

This week saw moderate numbers in both person and property offences. Res B&Es saw a drop to nil. Auto crime also saw a drop, whereas TFAs remain moderate.

Geographically we saw activity in all of the core areas once again, with activity also in Tilbury and Annacis. And our area of concentration remained up north, in D3 with a smaller hot spot occurring also in Tsawwassen.

PROPERTY OFFENCES

AUTO THEFT

We had 2 Auto Theft files over the last week, both in D3 with one on Annacis. The Annacis file was a trailer theft where a Great Dane Trailer and is yet to be recovered (863). We also saw 2 outside recovered stolens – both Surrey stolens and both recovered in D3 – one in very close proximity to Delta stolen at 115th and 86th.

BUSINESS BREAK AND ENTER

We had 3 Bus B&Es– 1 in Tilbury (glass removal), 1 on Annacis (compound – nothing stolen), and 1 along Scott Rd (Hydro room – copper pipe stolen). The Scott Rd B&E was similar in MO to an Other B&E occurring several days prior, where a sprinkler room was targeted also for copper piping.

RESIDENTIAL BREAK AND ENTER

Res B&Es were at nil for the week, down from 5 last week

OTHER BREAK AND ENTER

Oth B&Es were up to 4 and occurred in Tsawwassen (storage lockers – 2 files), Ladner (res under demolition), and D4 (as above – sprinkler room). *Of special interest is the following:*

Res Under Demolition Person of Interest (874 – D2): A res under demolition was targeted for copper pipes, which were ripped out from the hot water tank, causing the house to flood. A vehicle was observed – described as a **black Ford F150 Super Duty**.

THEFT FROM AUTO

TFA's were at 14 reported incidents for the week with Tsawwassen hit the hardest, as well as incidents at the North 40 Dog Park, Annacis, North Delta and 1 each in Ladner and Tilbury. Of special interest are the following:

Tsawwassen TFA Suspect (624 – D1): A vehicle was targeted with a door pry TFA in Tsawwassen, where items were stolen and the plate was replaced with a plate from Surrey that was associated to a mail theft incident occurring there.

Theft of Dashboard (916 – D2): A tractor unit was targeted in Tilbury for the theft of its dashboard (\$3000 value). The tractor unit was parked in the back lot overnight. No signs of forced entry.

Gas Pumping Theft (807 – D4): While pumping gas in D4, COM has their wallet stolen from the passenger side of the vehicle. Although not a recent series, we have seen similar incidents in the past and perhaps something to be aware of.

ADDITIONAL PROPERTY CRIME FILES OF INTEREST

Files of interest include the following:

Mail Theft Suspects (978 – D4): An attempt mail theft occurred in D4 this past week where **4 Caucasian male suspects were observed, 20-40 yrs old, associated to a black Cadillac SUV and 2 grey sedans.** Males fled after being yelled at my COM. Burnaby stolen mail was located at the scene.



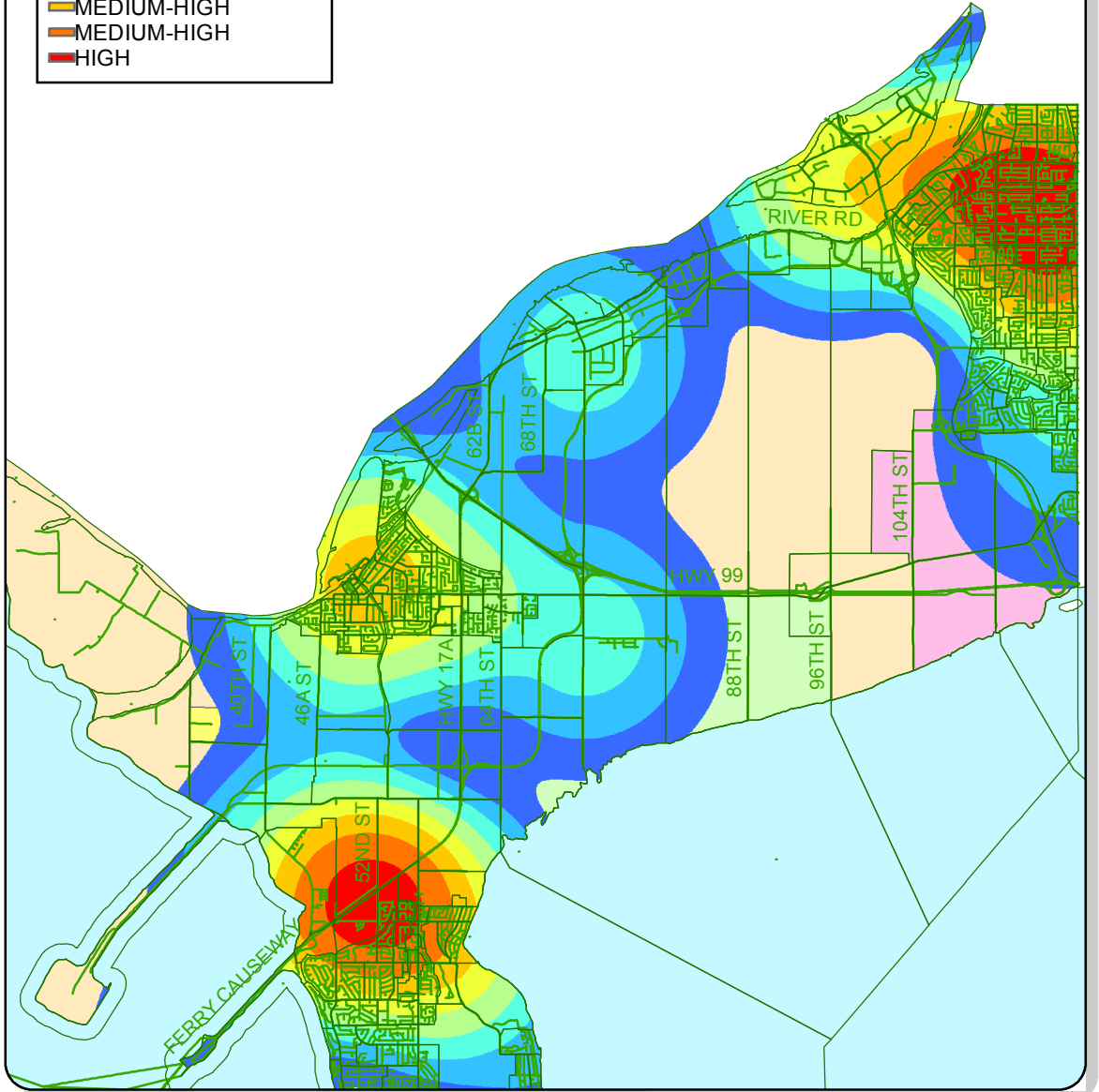
PERSONS OFFENCES

Persons Offences were at 4 assaults and 1 robbery for the week. Of the 4 assaults, 2 were domestics, 1 was a stranger assault at a pool hall, and 1 was a grab/threat in the Safeway parking lot where male grabbed complainant by the arm and told her she better watch her back.

The robbery this period occurred in Memorial Park where an intoxicated COM stated she was assaulted by a group of 6 Caucasian males, 15-17 years old, and had her wallet and bottle of wine stolen.
