

OFFENCE ACTIVITY WEEK IN REVIEW - 2017-01-16 TO 2017-01-22

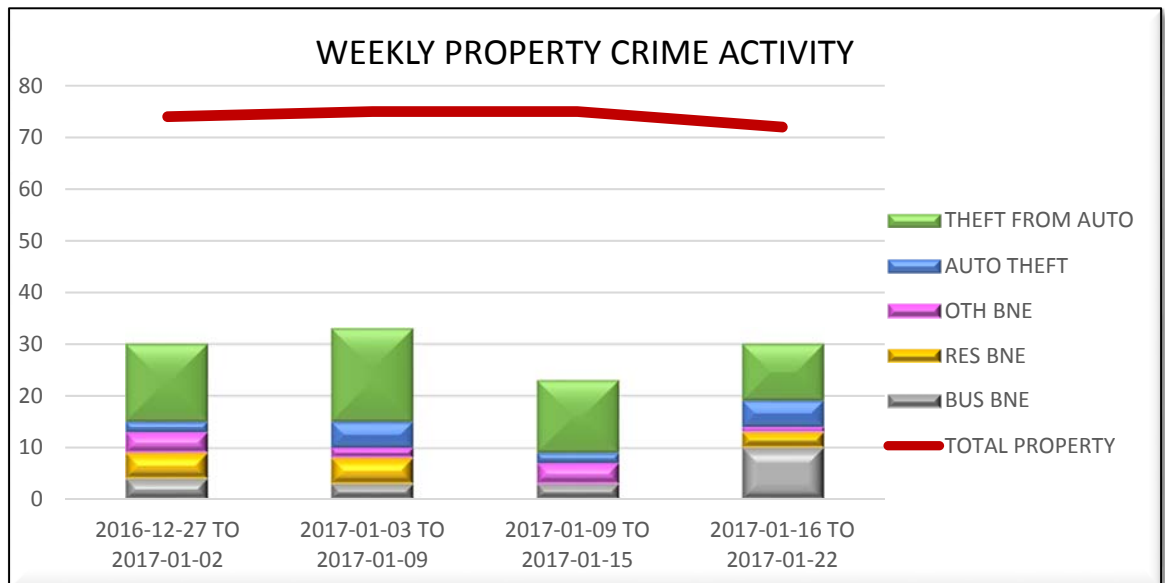
D1: Tsawwassen D2: Ladner/Tilbury D3: North Delta/Annacis D4: Scottsdale

This week saw increased numbers in both Person and Property crimes. Violent crime saw 3 assaults and nil robberies. Property crime saw higher Bus B&E levels, and moderate numbers in all other major offence types.

Year-to-date B&Es are up as are TFAs but Auto Theft is actually down. Violent crime is down in both major offence types.

Geographically, this past week saw a hot spot of activity along Scott Rd in both D3/D4, as well as moderate activity on Annacis.

PROPERTY OFFENCES

AUTO THEFT

We had 5 Auto Theft files over the last week – 1 in D2, 1 in D4, 2 in North Delta and 1 on Annacis. Of interest is the following:

B&E/Auto Theft (1139/1050 – D2): Business in D2 was targeted with a B&E this past week where a vehicle pushed in an overhead loading door and 2 vehicles were stolen – a white 1997 Ford F350 and a grey 2007 Volkswagen convertible. Vehicles have yet to be recovered.

BUSINESS BREAK AND ENTER

We had a higher number of Bus B&Es over the last week – 10 incidents occurred with 4 of these in Tilbury, 1 on Annacis, and 5 along Scott Rd in D4. Of interest are the following:

Tilbury B&E Persons of Interest (1065 – D2): A male in reflective gear cut the gate to business in Tilbury and entered the compound, casing the business, without taking anything. A day later the male returned with a female in a compact car. The female directed traffic in a reflective suit while the male entered the yard and stole copper, brass, and aluminum. The male returned a third time and stole a jerry can of gas.

Cigarette Theft (1033 – D4): Scott Rd was hit with a number of Bus B&Es this past week in D4. Domo Gas Station was one incident targeted, where a window smash occurred. Suspect appears to have cut the lock of a security shutter, broke the window then climbing inside. The male (believed to have worn gloves) then stole numerous packs of cigarettes. 3 of the additional files in the area had similar window smash MO.

RESIDENTIAL BREAK AND ENTER

Res B&Es were at 3 for the week – up from nil last week. Of the 3, 1 was an attempt to pry an interior door of an underground parkade in Tsawwassen (D1), and the remaining 2 occurred in D4 – 1 garage theft and 1 Res B&E. Of interest is the following:

Garage Theft Suspect (1108 – D4): COM observed an unknown male in his insecure garage attempting to steal the base of a water cooler. COM confronted the male who dropped the cooler and ran to a waiting vehicle across the street driven by a second unknown male. COM was able to get the BCL which came back as stolen.

OTHER BREAK AND ENTER

Oth B&Es were at 5 for the week and included an insecure construction site (Ladner), gas tank storage cage (Annacis), gas station storage shed (D3), and 2 underground parkades (D4).

THEFT FROM AUTO

TFAs were at 11 for the week with incidents in all core areas. Of interest is the following:

Catalytic Converter Theft Suspects (1450 – D3): An employee at a business on Annacis observed 2 males remove the side skirt from a tractor and crawl under to steal the catalytic converter.

ADDITIONAL PROPERTY CRIME FILES OF INTEREST

Files of interest include the following:

Bike Theft (1439/1437 – D1): We had 2 bike thefts this past week – both occurring in Tsawwassen.

Theft of Tanks on Annacis (1360, 1283 – D3): We had 2 incidents of theft of tanks this past week – both on Annacis – one where welding gas tanks were stolen (Oth B&E above), and 1 where propane tanks were taken from a locked cage.










Mail Theft (1099, 1117 – D4): We had 2 more mail theft files this past week, both from community mailboxes and both in D4 on the same night in close proximity to one another. Both appear to be pried with a crowbar and a suspect was observed in 1 incident, described as a **male associated to a white newer model 4dr sedan with a spoiler and believed to be a Toyota**. We have seen a recent increase in community mailbox thefts as well as associated frauds.

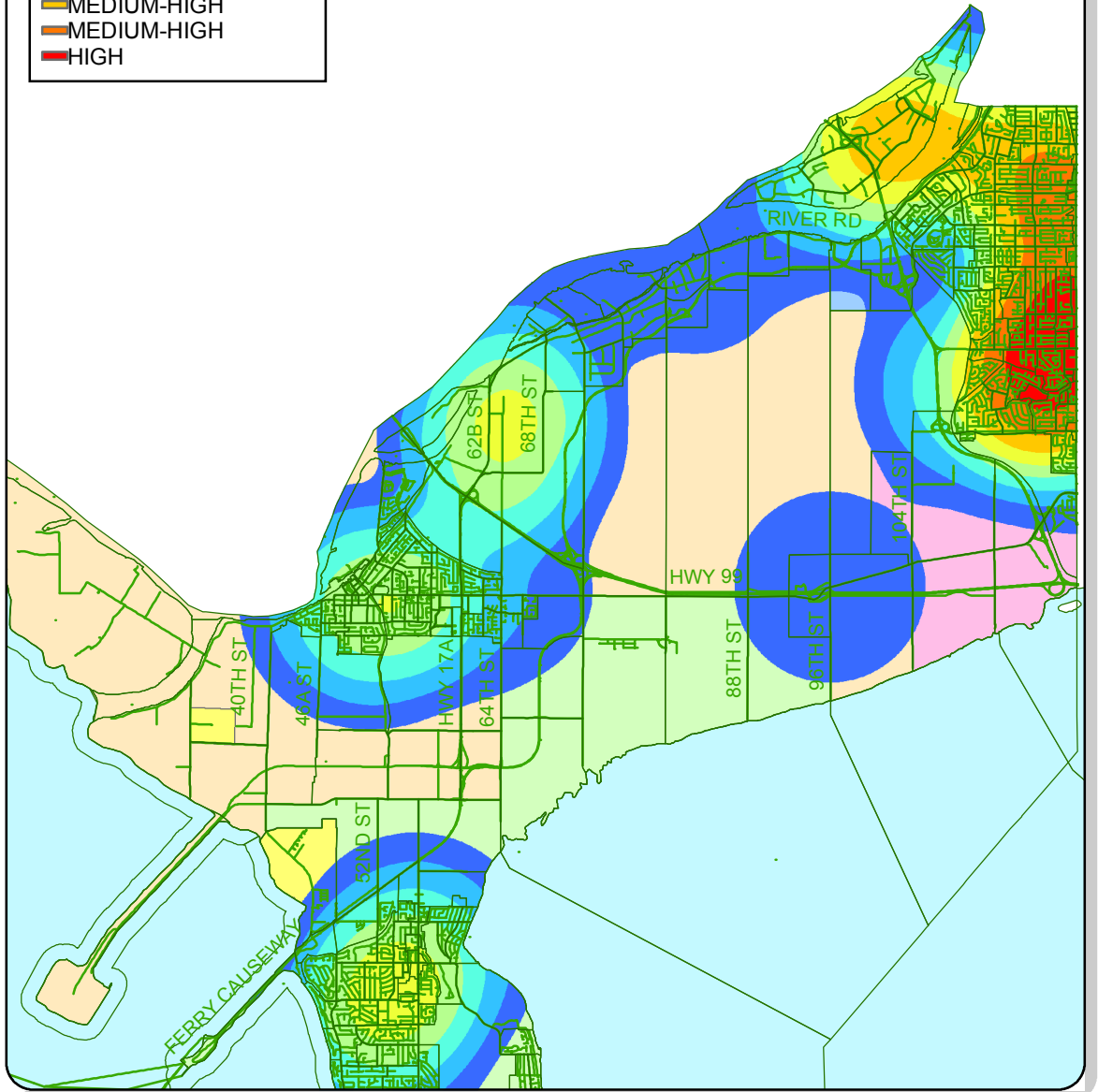


PERSONS OFFENCES

Persons Offences were moderate overall but included violent crime, 3 assaults and nil robberies. Of the 3 assaults, 1 was a family domestics, 1 was a customer pushing an employee, and 1 was a shoplifter assaulting a security guard.
