HATE CRIME TOOL KIT

The following reporting processes were put together with places of worship in mind, and are subsequently geared towards targeted events against the ideology of the property itself, or that of those on site.

If you see, or suspect a crime in progress (**EMERGENCY**):

- 1) Call **9-1-1**
- 2) Give your name, number, location, and high-level description of the incident
- 3) Answer any follow up questions safely, and to the best of your ability

If you suspect a crime has been committed (**NON-EMERGENCY**):

- 1) Call the **Delta Police Non-Emergency Line** at **604-946-4411**
- 2) Give your contact information, and a detailed description of the incident
- 3) Remain clear of the scene and prevent others from contaminating it
- 4) Allow members arriving on scene take photos and search for evidence
- 5) Confirm your information with members arriving on scene to investigate
- 6) Request the file number for follow up and recording purposes

Under the Criminal Code of Canada, a Hate Crime is defined as any criminal offence against a person, group, or property that is motivated by hatred or prejudice toward an identifiable group. These identifiable groups include, but are not limited to: Religion; Race, Colour, Ethnicity and Language; Sex or Sexual Orientation; Age; and Disability.
