DEPARTMENT PRIORITIES, GOALS & OBJECTIVES

POLICY

- 1. The Delta Police Board (Board) determines the priorities, goals and objectives of the Delta Police Department (Department).
- In determining its priorities, goals and objectives, the Board will take into account the same for policing and law enforcement of the provincial government and those of the City of Delta.
- 3. The Chief Constable shall give effect to the Board's priorities, goals and objectives through a Community Safety & Well-Being Plan (CSWP).

Police Act, 26(4)(5)

4. The CSWP shall be:

- a) further informed by obtaining input from members of the community, community partners, and Department employees (Partners);
- b) operationalized through an Annual Action Plan consisting of actionable steps to fulfill the Plan's priorities;
- c) implemented and executed by Department employees;
- d) assessed based on Key Performance Indicators established by the Chief Constable; and
- e) monitored and reported on in the following manner:
 - i) supervisors and managers shall regularly report on the Annual Action Plan to the Chief Constable,
 - ii) the Chief Constable shall report on the Annual Action Plan to the Board semi-annually, and

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- iii) the Chief Constable shall provide an Annual Report on the CSWP to the Board.
- 5. The CSWP, Annual Action Plan and Annual Report shall be made publicly available on the Department's website.

REASON FOR POLICY

- 6. To seek to ensure that Department priorities, goals and objectives consider the input of the province, the City of Delta, members of the community, community partners, and Department employees.
- 7. To seek to ensure Department operations monitor, achieve, and report on the priorities established in the CSWP.
